

Meeting Place of Rotary Club Brussels Cantersteen

Rotary Club Brussels Cantersteen holds its weekly statutory meetings in the strategically located, prestigious, **Stanhope Hotel**, Rue du Commerce 9, 1000 Brussels.

It is located at approximately in the European district, giving access from both Rue du Commerce and the square de Meeus.

For public transport, the metro station “Troon-trône” is only 175 m away, and busses stop both in Rue du Trône as in Rue du Luxembourg.

This 5star boutique hotel is a peaceful heaven in a prestigious turn-of-the-century Brussels residence, and is therefore very well suited to welcome Rotary members from all around the globe.

We have different rooms that can host our meetings to cater for 20 persons up till 100. They can be equipped with all kinds of audio-visual aids, to support our high-level speakers.

The meeting takes place every Tuesday night at 7:00 p.m., includes a dinner, with wine, water and coffee, and normally ends between 8:30 and 9:00 p.m.

Members are charged for meals for every meeting, present or not. The real cost per meal is higher of course, but our charge is based on 60% attendance. Prices of the meals depend on the kind of meeting (plenary meeting, cantor corner, ...). Guests are charged the full cost of the meal.
